INTRODUCTION

Introducing **Purple Pearl**, a 2015 Leopard 48 Owner's Version sailing catamaran that captures the spirit of modern bluewater cruising. The Leopard 48, designed by the respected naval architecture firm Simonis & Voogd and built in Cape Town, South Africa by Robertson & Caine, represents a major step forward in cruising catamaran design. Launched during a period when multihulls were rapidly evolving, the Leopard 48 introduced features that quickly became hallmarks of the brand, including its innovative forward cockpit access, raised helm station, and a focus on open, airy living spaces that seamlessly connect the interior and exterior of the vessel. The result is a cruising platform known for its balanced sailing performance, comfortable accommodations, and the stability that sailors have come to expect from a well-designed catamaran.

Purple Pearl highlights many of the qualities that have made the Leopard 48 such a sought-after model among cruising sailors. Configured in the desirable Owner's Version layout, the vessel dedicates the entire starboard hull to a spacious master suite while the port hull provides comfortable guest accommodations for family and friends. Throughout the vessel, thoughtful systems and equipment support extended time aboard, including a substantial solar array paired with a Victron lithium battery system, watermaker, modern navigation electronics, and onboard connectivity. Combined with the Leopard's signature forward cockpit seating area, expansive aft cockpit, and bright panoramic salon, Purple Pearl offers a versatile and comfortable platform for those looking to explore new coastlines, cruise the islands, or simply enjoy life on the water. In the sections that follow, you'll find a detailed room-by-room walkthrough of the vessel along with an overview of the systems and features that make Purple Pearl a compelling example of the popular Leopard 48.

ACCOMMODATIONS & LAYOUT

The Leopard 48 is well regarded for its thoughtful interior design, offering an impressive sense of space while maintaining the practical layout required for extended cruising. **Purple Pearl** is configured in the desirable **Owner's Version**, a three-cabin arrangement that dedicates the entire starboard hull to a private master suite while the port hull accommodates two comfortable guest staterooms. This layout creates a natural balance between privacy and shared living space, making the vessel well suited for

couples cruising long distances, families traveling together, or owners who frequently host guests aboard.

Entering the vessel from the aft cockpit, guests are welcomed into a bright and inviting main salon surrounded by expansive windows that provide excellent natural light and panoramic visibility. One of the defining features of the Leopard 48 design is the forward salon door, which leads directly to the forward cockpit seating area. This unique feature enhances airflow throughout the vessel while also creating an additional social space for relaxing underway or enjoying the breeze at anchor. From the salon, companionways lead down into each hull where the owner's suite and guest accommodations are arranged for both comfort and functionality. The result is a layout that feels open and connected while still providing private retreats for those on board.

MAIN SALON (SALOON)

The main saloon aboard **Purple Pearl** serves as the central gathering space of the vessel, offering a bright and welcoming environment designed for both relaxation and everyday living aboard. Surrounded by large panoramic windows, the space is filled with natural light while providing excellent visibility of the surrounding anchorage or coastline. The open layout creates a natural connection between the interior living space, the aft cockpit, and the forward cockpit seating area—one of the signature design features that helped define the Leopard 48.

A comfortable dinette seating area is positioned forward to starboard, providing a welcoming place for meals, navigation planning, or relaxing with guests. Opposite the seating area to port is the navigation station and access to the port hull guest accommodations. The galley is conveniently located aft within the saloon, allowing easy communication with both the interior and cockpit entertaining areas. A sliding glass door opens fully to the aft cockpit, creating a seamless transition between indoor and outdoor living spaces. The result is a saloon that feels open, functional, and perfectly suited for life aboard whether underway or at anchor.

GALLEY

The galley aboard **Purple Pearl** is thoughtfully positioned aft within the saloon, creating a functional and social cooking space that remains connected to both the interior living area and the cockpit. This arrangement allows meals and refreshments to be prepared while still remaining part of the conversation with guests relaxing inside or outside. With the large sliding salon door open to the cockpit and the forward salon door providing additional airflow, the galley benefits from excellent ventilation and natural light, making it a pleasant workspace whether preparing a quick breakfast or a full evening meal at anchor.

Designed with practicality in mind for extended cruising, the galley offers generous counter space, abundant storage, and durable finishes throughout. The layout provides easy access to refrigeration, cooking appliances, and sink areas, allowing efficient movement while cooking underway or in port. Stainless steel fixtures, Corian countertops, and well-organized cabinetry create a clean, modern working environment while ensuring everything needed for life aboard is within reach.

The suite is arranged with a generous aft berth, ample storage throughout, and additional cabinetry and shelving that make long-term living aboard practical and organized. Forward in the hull, the ensuite head provides a dedicated private bathroom complete with shower and vanity, allowing owners to enjoy both privacy and comfort while cruising. Thoughtful finishes and clean, modern materials carry through the space, creating a calm and inviting environment that serves as a relaxing retreat after a day on the water.

The combination of the expansive aft cockpit, elevated helm station, and the Leopard's signature forward cockpit lounge creates a versatile layout that allows guests and crew to comfortably enjoy the outdoors in a variety of conditions.

From the twin sugarscoop swim platforms at the stern to the comfortable seating areas forward, the deck layout offers a natural flow between social spaces and working areas. These exterior spaces are equally suited for entertaining guests in a quiet anchorage, managing sail operations underway, or simply enjoying the surrounding scenery from different vantage points around the vessel. In the sections that follow, we'll take a closer look at the cockpit, helm station, foredeck, and other exterior features that make the Leopard 48 such a well-rounded cruising catamaran.

SUGARSCOOPS & TRANSOM

The transom and sugarscoop platforms aboard ***Purple Pearl*** provide easy and convenient access to the water, making them ideal for swimming, launching the tender, or boarding from a dock. Positioned close to the waterline, the twin sugarscoops allow guests to step aboard comfortably from either side while also serving as practical staging areas for water activities.

The transom area also provides direct access to the engine compartments, allowing routine inspections and maintenance to be carried out easily without entering the interior living spaces. A robust dinghy davit system supports the vessel's tender, allowing it to be safely lifted clear of the water while underway and quickly launched when it's time to explore nearby anchorages or head ashore. Whether returning from a swim, boarding from the tender, or preparing for the next adventure, the transom area serves as a practical and well-designed gateway between the boat and the sea.

COCKPIT

The aft cockpit aboard *Purple Pearl* serves as one of the primary outdoor living spaces of the vessel, offering a spacious and comfortable area for dining, entertaining, or relaxing while enjoying the surrounding scenery. Located directly aft of the main salon, the cockpit connects seamlessly with the interior through a large sliding glass door, allowing the salon and cockpit to function together as one continuous living space when entertaining or spending time aboard.

Protected by the cockpit hardtop, the area provides welcome shade during warm days while still allowing open airflow and excellent visibility of the surrounding anchorage. The cockpit can also be enclosed with canvas and Eisenglass panels, creating a sheltered outdoor living space that provides additional protection from wind, rain, and spray. This enclosure greatly expands the usable living area of the vessel in a wide range of cruising conditions, allowing the cockpit to remain a comfortable gathering place even during cooler evenings or unsettled weather.

Generous seating surrounds the cockpit dining table, creating an inviting space for outdoor meals or casual conversation with family and guests. Easy access to the side decks, helm station, and sugarscoop swim platforms ensures smooth movement around the vessel whether underway, anchoring, or preparing for water activities.

RAISED HELM STATION

The raised helm station aboard *Purple Pearl* provides an excellent command position with clear visibility of the cockpit, foredeck, and surrounding waters. Positioned just a few steps above the aft cockpit, the helm allows the operator to remain connected with guests and crew while still benefiting from improved sightlines for navigation, sail handling, and docking. This elevated helm arrangement is one of the signature design features of the Leopard 48, combining the advantages of improved visibility with easy communication between the helm and cockpit areas.

The helm platform is protected by the cockpit hardtop and can be further enclosed with canvas and Eisenglass panels, creating a sheltered steering station when cruising in cooler weather or during offshore passages. This enclosure provides additional protection from wind and spray while still maintaining good visibility, making the helm comfortable to operate in a variety of conditions. From this centralized control position, the helmsman can manage navigation and sail handling while remaining within easy reach of many sailing controls.

Located just forward of the main salon and accessible directly through the forward salon door, this comfortable seating area creates an additional outdoor living space that can be enjoyed while underway or at anchor. The forward cockpit provides a unique vantage point for enjoying the breeze, watching sunsets, or relaxing while taking in the surrounding scenery.

The area features comfortable seating and easy access to the foredeck, allowing guests to move naturally between lounging areas and the working deck space used for anchoring and sail handling. The forward cockpit also improves natural ventilation throughout the vessel, allowing fresh air to flow through the salon when both the forward door and aft cockpit doors are open. This thoughtful design enhances both comfort and livability aboard, making the space a favorite gathering spot for many owners.

Moving forward beyond the seating area, the foredeck provides ample room for safe movement while working lines, handling sails, or managing the ground tackle. Wide side decks and sturdy handholds make it easy to move about the vessel when anchoring, docking, or enjoying time forward.

These forward spaces are particularly useful for keeping bulky items such as spare lines, fenders, sails, and cruising equipment organized and out of the primary living areas of the vessel. When used as accommodations, the compartments provide a simple berth and ventilation through deck hatches, offering basic sleeping quarters suitable for occasional crew or additional guests.

Additional downwind sail options further enhance the vessel's sailing capabilities, allowing the crew to take advantage of favorable conditions while maintaining efficient performance.

This twin-engine configuration allows for precise handling and redundancy, making close-quarters maneuvering in marinas or anchorages more controlled and predictable. The engines are easily accessed from the transom areas, allowing routine inspections and maintenance to be performed without entering the vessel's interior living spaces.

The vessel is also equipped with onboard systems designed to support extended cruising and comfortable life aboard. These include freshwater production through a watermaker, climate control systems for interior comfort, and various mechanical equipment that enhance the vessel's independence while traveling between ports and anchorages.

The electrical system aboard **Purple Pearl** has been enhanced to support modern cruising demands and increased onboard independence.
