## INTRODUCTION

In the southern hemisphere, where the winds roar and the waters are deep and unforgiving, you'll find Cape Town, South Africa. This location has a high demand for capable BlueWater vessels. Robertson & Caine met this demand with their Leopard 58: **Sea Dog**. **Sea Dog** was built in 2020 as a BlueWater sailing catamaran and, through multiple upgrades in 2023 and 2025, is equipped for both long and short voyages. Designed for space and livability, she'll comfortably house family and friends without compromising storage or cruising efficiency.

**Sea Dog** is a capable sailing yacht seeking a captain to put her to use. Whether you aim to spend time cruising in the Caribbean, enjoying easier, shorter sailing days and a friendly community, or you want to stretch beyond into the South Pacific, finding undiscovered islands, sailing across oceans, and immersing yourself in new cultures, **Sea Dog** will get you there. And once aboard, that intention becomes immediately clear.

### **ACCOMMODATIONS & LAYOUT**

**Sea Dog** features a four-cabin, four-head layout, with the owner's suite in the starboard hull. A room and a head for every person, ensuring privacy and removing the obligation to share a head with someone else.

### **MAIN SALON (SALOON)**

The heart of every sailing vessel, where the family goes to plan, to relax, and to enjoy each other's company. **Sea Dog's** Saloon has wraparound windows for natural lighting, an open galley that connects with the saloon, and a large sliding door that effortlessly connects the cockpit with the saloon itself.

### **GALLEY**

The current owners removed a dishwasher for more storage, but all electrical and plumbing remain for a potential dishwasher refit.

#### **COCKPIT**

The cockpit is open and spacious, with the ability to move furniture where you please. Not only does it serve as a functional space, but it is also a social space that connects directly to the saloon via a large glass sliding door. With 4 shallow storage lockers beneath the cockpit in the lazarettes, there is even more space for toys and gear aboard.

### **FLYBRIDGE**

One of the core features of *Sea Dog* is the flybridge. It serves as both a command center and a social space. With a beautiful 360° view, it's an excellent place to converse with others and enjoy the scenery where you're anchored, which also provides a cool breeze. Not to mention the summer kitchen, which includes an electric grill and a mini fridge for cooking and storing beverages. With throttle control and a wheel, you're able to man *Sea Dog*, trim sails, and maneuver comfortably all from her twin helm seats. With a complete isinglass all-season enclosure, it provides protection from the elements if things get rough.

### **FOREDECK**

The foredeck offers a space for sail handling, anchoring, and relaxation. When you step through the triple-dogged glass door, connecting you from the saloon to the foredeck, you'll find yourself with forward-facing seating tucked in the bow of *Sea Dog*. There's faux teak and an angled deck that allows water to drain at the base of the dogged door. It is the first spot to catch a cool breeze, and there is additional storage beneath the L-shaped settee seating. Additionally, there are two collapsible tables so you can enjoy a meal or a glass of wine under the shade of the roof, which spans over the entirety of the foredeck. Access to the windlass is located here also, ensuring you never miss a moment with your crew when working and getting *Sea Dog's* anchor set.

### **ELECTRIC SWIM PLATFORM**

A space for those who want to sit in the water, the electric platform lowers enough to float the tender. If you're into watersports, it is a prime location to launch a kite, take off on a wakeboard, etc. Previously upgraded for a bigger dinghy, it enables further exploration and access to the islands and docks.
